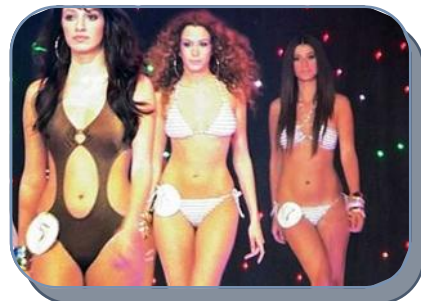


Film Synopsis
